2. COLLECTION OF INFORMATION

ABCompliance collects various types of information. This includes:

- a. Information that you provide us in the course of using the ABCompliance service, such as your name, residential or business address, e-mail address, and telephone number.
- b. Details of the services which you require from ABCompliance.
- c. We may also collect certain sensitive information from you i.e. date of birth, passport number and drivers licence number.

We collect personal information in order:

- d. To provide services and products to you and undertake associated business processes and functions

3. SHARING INFORMATION WITH OTHERS

ABCompliance will not sell or lease the information we collect to third parties for their promotional purposes unless we receive your permission to do so. Nevertheless, we may share personal information about you as follows:

To entities or service providers under contract with ABCompliance for the purposes of conducting our business and providing our services to you.

In the event of the sale, acquisition or merger of some or all of our assets, your personal information might be a part of the transferred assets. We shall notify you in the event of such an occurrence by placing a notice on our website.

Law enforcement and government officials, but only in connection with a formal request, subpoena, court order, or similar legal procedure, as well as circumstances where we believe in good faith that disclosure is necessary to comply with the law.

4. ACCESS TO INFORMATION
